Sub: Child Care Leave to Central Government employees - regardeng

The undersigned is directed to say that subsequent to assect of this Department OM of even number dated 07 69-2010, this Department has been receiving references from various Departments, seeking clarifications. The doubts raised are clarified as under

1. Whether Earned Leave availed for any purpose can be converted total Child Care Leave? How should applications where the purpose of availing leave has been indicated as "Lingent Work" but the applicant claims to have utilized the leave for taking a re of the needs of the child be treated?

Child Care Louve is sanctioned to women employees having numer children, for rearing or for looking after their needs like examination, sickness etc. Hence Earned Leave availed specifically for this purpose only should be converted

2. Whether all Earned Leave availed trespective of number of days it eless than 15 days, and number of spells can be converted? In cases where the CCL spills over to the next year, for example 30 days it is from 27th December), whether the Leave should be neated as one spells or two spells?

No. As the instructions contained in the OM gated 7.9.2000 has been given retrospective effect, all the conditions specified in the OM would have to be fulfilled for convention at the flurned be we into Child Care Leave. In cases where the leave spills over to the next year, it may be treated as one spell against the year or which the leave commences.

I. Whether those who have availed Chald Care this are note than a spells with less than 15 days can be not further Chald Care neare for the remaining period of the current year.

No. As per the OM of even number dated "9.2010. Child that Leave may not be granted in more than 1 spc. s. Hence CCI minimot be allowed more than 3 times or expective of the number of days or times Child Care Leave has been stanted earlier. Past cases may not be reopened.

4. Whether LTC can be availed during Child Care fease?

LTC cannot be availed during Child Care I care as I hald Care Leave is granted for the specific purpose of taking care of a minor child for rearing or for looking after any other needs of the child during examination, sickness etc.
