## **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Removal of Note 2 under Column 8 (11) Hospital treatment, in form Medical 97.

The undersigned is directed to state that CS (MA) beneficiaries have to use form, Med 97 for claiming refund of medical expenses in connection with medical attendance and/or treatment of Central Government servants and their family. Note 2 under Col.8 II (Hospital Treatment) stipulates that if a treatment was received at a hospital other than a Government hospital, necessary details and the certificate of the Authorized Medical Attendant that the requisite treatment was not available in any nearest Government hospital should be furnished.

2. The undersigned is also directed to state that a number of representations from various hospitals, Central Government Employees Welfare Coordination Committees and from various Ministries were received in the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare stating that the conditions of non-availability of the requisite treatment in any nearest Government hospital is creating problem in as much as these hospitals are always over crowded and valuable time is lost by the patients in getting treated at Government hospital.

3. The representations received in the Ministry have been examined carefully and the undersigned is directed to convey the approval of the competent authority to delete Note 2 under Col.8 II of form, Med 97.

4. The removal of Note 2 of Col.8 II of form, Med 97 implies that henceforth certificate from the AMA about the treatment not available in any Government hospital is being dispensed with.

5. The instruction contained in the Office Memorandum comes into effect from the date of issue of this Office Memorandum.

6. This Office Memorandum issues with the concurrence of IFD vide Dy. No.4963-AS&FA dated 19.9.2007.
