Subject: Transport allowance to part-time medical doctors at ICAR
Institutes-reg.

Sir,

Reference is invited to the Council's letter of even no. dated the 15th July, 2009 vide which the rates of remuneration of part-time medical doctors engaged by the ICAR Research Institutes for outdoor medical treatment of employees and their families were revised by the Council as under:-

Institutes	Revised remuneration range
For Institutes other than those located in NEH Region	₹5000-8000 per month
For Institutes located in NEH Region	₹6000-10000 per month

In the last Director's Conference held at the NBPGR, New Delhi on 15.7.2011, the Directors had raised the issue of enhancement of rates of remuneration of part-time medical doctors in view of the difficulties being faced by the Institutes in engaging part-time medical doctors at the existing rates of remuneration. It was pointed out that some of the part-time medical doctors were staying far away from the Institutes and had to incur a huge amount on travel etc. to and from the Institutes. It was suggested that some transport/conveyance allowance may also be allowed to part-time medical doctors in addition to the remuneration payable to partly compensate them for travel costs incurred by them.

The matter has been considered in the light of deliberations in the last Director's Conference and references received from various ICAR Institutes and it has accordingly been decided with the approval of the competent authority in the ICAR to allow transport allowance to the part-time medical doctors engaged by the ICAR Institutes in addition to the remuneration payable as under:-

- (i) If the Institute is more than 10 km beyond the Municipal boundary, the part-time medical doctor may be allowed a transport allowance not exceeding ₹750 per month subject to the condition that the doctor concerned would make at least six visits to the Institutes in a month. For lesser number of visits, the amount of transport allowance may be reduced proportionately.
- (ii) If the Institute is more than 15 km outside the Municipal limit, the part-time medical doctors may be allowed a transport allowance not exceeding ₹1000 per month subject to at least six visits in a month. If the number of visit is less, the amount may be reduced proportionately.

These instructions will be effective from 1.1.2012.

This issues with the concurrence of FA(DARE/ICAR) vide dy.no. 2267/F dated 28.12.2011.


