Office Memorandum

Subject - Payment of Ex-Gratia lump-sum compensation to Central Civil personnel who are boarded out of service on account of disability attributable to or aggravated in service -- regarding-

The undersigned is directed to say that families of the Central Civil servants including Central Para Military Forces now known as Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF), who die in performance of their bonafide duties and the Government servant who sustain injuries and are disabled or incapacitated on account of causes which are accepted as attributable to or aggravated by government service, are eligible for pensionary benefits under the Central Civil Services (Extraordinary Pension) Rules. Further, in terms of Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare O.M No 45/55/97-P&PW(C) dated 11/9/1998 read with OM No. 38/37/2008-P&PW (A) dated 2/9/2008 an ex gratia lump sum compensation is available to the families of Central Government Civilian employee, who die in the performance of their bona fide official duties under various circumstances.

2 The question of granting lump sum ex-gratia compensation to the personnel belonging to Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF), who are boarded out of service on account of disability attributable to or aggravated in service, had been under consideration of the Government for some time considering the hardship being faced by the disabled Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) personnel

3 Accordingly, Ministry of Home Affairs vide their OM No 27011/64/2009-R&W dated 21st April, 2011 had issued instructions for the personnel of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF). A copy of that OM is enclosed

4 The feasibility of providing similar ex-gratia lump sum compensation to Central Civil servants covered by CCS (EOP) Rules is being examined in this Department

5 It is requested that the information regarding number of cases in which a Central Civil servants sustain injuries and are boarded out on account of disability attributable to Government service during the period of 1.4.2010 to 31.3.2011 may be sent to this Department. The percentage of disability in each case may also please be indicated

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Payment of ex-Gratia lump sum compensation to CPMF (now CAPF) personnel who are boarded out of service on account of disability attributable to or aggravated in service.

The undersigned is directed to say that the Central Paramilitary Forces (CPMF) now Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) personnel, who sustain injuries and become disabled or incapacitated on account of causes accepted or attributable to or aggravated by Government service, are eligible for certain special benefits under the Central Civil Services (Extraordinary Pension) Rules. The benefits available under these Rules have been amended and liberalized from time to time.

2 The question of granting a lump sum ex-gratia compensation to personnel belonging to CAPFs, who are boarded out of service on account of disability attributable to or aggravated in service, has been under consideration of the Government.

3 It has now been decided that such CAPFs personnel, who are disabled in the performance of their bonafide official duties under various circumstances and are boarded out from service on account of disability attributable to or aggravated in service, shall be paid ex gratia compensation amounting to Rs. 9 lakhs for 100% disability. For cases with less than 100% disability, the amount of ex-gratia compensation may be reduced in proportion to the degree of disability, e.g., for 50% disability an ex-gratia compensation of Rs. 4.5 lakhs will be payable. However, a minimum of 20% disability will be the condition for grant of ex-gratia compensation. The proportionate compensation would be based on actual percentage of disability without any board banding provisions as contained in DOP&PW OM No. 45/22/97-P&PW(C) dated 03/2/2000.

4. The other terms and conditions for admissibility of ex-gratia lump sum compensation pertaining to the circumstances, specifies in DOP&PW's OM NO. 5/55/97-P&PW(C) dated 11/9/1998 and No. 36/37/08-P&PW (A) dated 02/09/2008 will be applicable to decide each individual case by the Administrative Ministries concerned in consultation with their Financial Advisers.
