The Padma Awards, namely, Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri, are amongst the highest civilian awards of the country. Instituted in 1954, these awards are announced on the occasion of the Republic Day every year. The award seeks to recognize 'work of any distinction' and is given for distinguished and exceptional achievements/service in all fields/disciplines, such as, Art, Literature and Education, Sports, Medicine, Social Work, Science and Engineering, Public Affairs, Civil Service, Trade and Industry etc. All persons without distinction of race, occupation, position or sex are eligible for these awards. A copy of the statutes and rules governing these awards is enclosed (Annex - I).

- 2. It is the conventional practice to invite nominations for these awards from all Ministries / Departments of the Government of India as also several other sources to enable broad-based consideration. The nominations are to be sent in the enclosed proforma (Annex II). As you would notice from the proforma, in addition to the bio-data, a detailed write up (citation) in narrative form, clearly bringing out the distinguished and exceptional achievements/service of the person recommended in his/ her respective field/discipline, has to be provided in each case. All relevant columns of the proforma are also expected to be completed in all respects. The process of compiling the nominations/recommendations and their consideration takes considerable time and, therefore, commences early.
- 3. It has been observed in the past that while nominations are received in respect of a large number of persons, there could, however, be several talented persons who are left out of consideration despite exceptional contribution in their field. Often many of these persons may get overlooked primarily for the reason that they may not seek publicity or attention in the public domain. I would, therefore, request you to make concerted efforts in identifying such persons whose excellence and achievements really deserve to be recognized, and make suitable nominations in their favour. It goes without saying that recognition of such deserving persons will only radd to the lustre of these awards.
- 4. In the above background, I am to request you to kindly send suitable nominations for the Padma awards to be announced on the occasion of Republic Day, 2011. While finalizing the recommendations, the following points may be kept in view:-

- (i) It may be ensured that the persons recommended are pre-eminently worthy of the awards, looking at their life-time achievement. The criteria for selection should invariably be 'excellence plus' and the highest standards should be applied while recommending persons for these awards. The existence of an element of public service in the achievements of the person recommended for the award would be a desirable factor.
- (ii) Efforts may be made to identify talented persons from amongst the weaker sections of the society, like SCs & STs, handicapped persons, women, etc., who deserve to be considered for the award.
- (iii) Where a person employed under any autonomous organization or public sector undertaking of the Central Government is recommended for any of these awards, it may be ensured that his / her employer is invariably consulted.
- (iv) The decoration is normally not conferred posthumously. However, in highly deserving cases, Government could consider giving an award posthumously if the demise of the person proposed to be honoured has been recent, say within a period of one year preceding the Republic Day on which it is proposed to announce the award.
- (v) A higher category of Padma award can be considered in respect of a person who has earlier been conferred an award provided a period of at least five years has elapsed. However, in exceptionally deserving cases, a relaxation can be considered.
- 5. The last date for receipt of the recommendations for Padma Awards in this Ministry is October 1, 2010. The cut-off date may please be strictly adhered to as it may not be possible to consider the recommendations received thereafter.

The following is a reprint of Nutification Nos. 1-Pres. 155, 2-Pres. 155, 3-Pres. 155 and 4-Pres. 155, dated 8th January, 1955, as amended upto 1st January, 1969.

# OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY TO THE PRESIDENT,

#### NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 8th January, 1955.

No. 1-Pres./55—The President is pleased to make the following revised regulations for the award of the decoration BHARAT RATNA in supersection of those published in Notification No. 1-Pres./54, dated the 2nd January, 1954:—

- The decoration shall be conferred by the President by a Sanad under his hand and seal.
- 2 The decoration shall be in the form of a Peepul loaf, two and five-sixteenth inches in length, one and seven-eighth inches at its greatest breadth and ene-eighth of an inch in thinkness. It shall be of toned bronze. On its obverse shall be embossed a replice of the Sun five-eighths of an inch in dismeter with rays aprending out from five-sixteenths of an inch to half an inch from the centre of the Sun, below which shall be embossed the words BHARAT MATINA in Hindl. On the reverse shall be embossed the State Emblem and motto in Hindl. The Emblem (but not the motto), the Sun and the dim shall be of plathnum. The inscriptions shall be of @burnished bronze.
- 3. A scaled pattern of the decoration (manufactured according to the specifications described above and the drawing in the anneaure to these regulations) shall be deposited and kept.
- 4. The decoration shall be worn round the neck by a white riband 96 one and a half luches in width.

- 5. The decoration shall be awarded for exceptional service towards the advancement of Art, Literature and Science, and in recognition of public service of the highest order.
- Any person without distinction of recooccupation, position or sex shall be eligible for the award.
- 7. The decoration may be awarded posthus mously.
- 8. The names of the persons, upon when the decoration is conferred, shall be published in the Gazetic of India and a register of all such recipients shall be maintained under the direction of the President.
- \*9. The ministers of the decoration which may be worn on certain occasions by recipients shall be half the size of the BHARAT RATNA, and a sealed pattern of the said ministers shall be deposited and kept.
- 10. The Precident may cancel and annul the award of the decoration to any person and thereupon his name shall be crased from the Register and he shall be required to surrander the decoration and the Sanad. But it shall be competent for the President to restore the decoration and Sanad and to withdraw the orders of cancellation and annulment. The notice of cancellation or restoration in every case shall be published in the Ozzatio of India,
- 11. All persons upon whom the decoration BHARAT RATNA was conferred under the Regulations issued with Notification No. 1-Pres/54, dated the 2nd January, 1954, shall, for all purposes of those Regulations, be deemed to be persons on whom the decuration BHARAT RATNA has been conferred by the President.

No. 2-Pres/55—The President is pleased to make the following revised regulations for the award of the decoration PADMA VIBHUSHAN in supersession of those published in Notification No. 2-Pres/54, dated the 2nd January, 1954;—

- 1. The decoration shall be conferred by the President by a Sanad under his hand and seal.
- 2 The decoration shall be unitally circular in design, with a geometrical puttern superimposed on the circle (as in the representative drawing in the unnexuro). The diameter of the elecular portion of the decoration shall be one and three-fourth inches and the thickness of the decoration shall be oneeighth of an inch. The geometrical pattern shall be composed of the outer lines of a square of one and three-sixteenths inches side, centrally placed on each side of which shall be a rectangle projecting beyond the rim thereby breaking the circumference of the circular design of the decoration. A knob shall be embossed within each of the outer angles of the geometrical pattern. There shall be a raised circular space of diameter one and one-sixteenth inches forming the centre-piece of the decoration. On the obverse a latus flower shall be embossed in this circular space. The name of the decoration shall be embossed in Hindl, with the word PADMA placed above and the word VIBHUSHAN placed below the total flower. On the revenue shall be embossed the State Emblem and motto in Hindi below it. The devoration shall be of toned bronze, @The inscription PADMA VIBIOUSHAN on the obverse of the decoration, the geometrical pattern on either side and the horder around the periphery, shall be of burnished becars. All embossing on either side of the decurstion shall be of while gold.
- 3. A souled pattern of the decoration (manuflictured according to the specifications described above and the drawing in the annexage to these regulations) shall be deposited and kept.


- 4. The december shall be worn by men on the left breast, suspended from a plain lotus plack riband one and a quarter inches in width; and by women on the left shoulder, suspended from a riband of the same colour and width fashloned into a bow.
- 5. The decoration shall be awarded for exceptional and distinguished service in any field including service rendered by Government servants.
- 6. Any person without distinction of rate, occupation, position or sex shall be eligible for the award.
- 7. The decoration may be awarded posthumously.
- 8. The names of the persons, upon whom the decoration is conferred, shall be published in the Gazette of India and a register of all such recipients shall be maintained under the direction of the President.
- \*9. The miniature of the decoration which may be worn on certain occasions by recipients shall be half the size of the PADMA VIBHUSHAM, and a scaled pattern of the said miniature shall be deposited and kept.
- 10. The President may cancel and annul the award of the decoration to any person and thereupon his name shall be crassed from the Register and he shall be required to surrender the decoration and the Stand. But it shall be competent for the President to restore the decoration and Sanad and to withdraw the orders of cancellation and sunulment. The notice of cancellation or restoration in every case that the published in the Cazette of India.
- 11. All persons upon whom the decoration of PADMA VIBHUSHAN (PAHELA VARG) was conferred under the Regulations issued with Notification No. 2-Pros/54, dated the 2nd January, 1954, shall, for all purposes of these regulations, be deemed to persons on whom the decoration of PADMA VIBHUSHAN has been conferred by the President



No. 3-Pres/55—The President is pleased to make the following revised regulations for the award of the decoration PADMA BHUSHAN in supersession of those published in Notification No. 2-Pres/54, dated the 2nd January, 1954:—

- The decoration shall be conferred by the President by a Saind under his hand and seal.
- 2. The decoration shall be mainly circular in design, with a geometrical pattern superimposed on the circle (as in the representative drawing in the annexure). The diameter of the circular portion of the decoration shall be one and three-fourth inches and the thickness of the decoration shall be oneeighth of an inch. The geometrical pattern shall be composed of the outer lines of a square of one and three-sixteenths inches side, centrally placed on each alde of which shall be a rectangle projecting beyond the rim thereby breaking the circumference of the circular design of the decoration. A knob shall be embossed within each of the outer angles of the geometrical pattern. There shall be a raised circular space of diameter one and one-sixteenth usches forming the centre-piece of the decoration. On the obverse a lotus flower shall be embossed in this circular space. The name of the decoration shall be embossed in Hindi, with the word PADMA placed above and the word BHUSHAN placed below the lotus flower. On the reverse shall be embossed the State Emblem and motto in Hindi below it, The decoration shall be of toued bronze. @The inscription PADMA BHUSHAN on the obverse of the decorntion, the geometrical pattern on either side and the border around the periphery, shall be of burnished bronze. All embossing on either side of the decoration shall be of standard gold.
- 3. A scaled pattern of the decoration (manufactured according to the specifications described above and the drawing in the annexure to these regulations) shall be deposited and kept.


- 4. The deportion shall be worn by men on the left breast, suspended from a plain lotus pink riband one and a quarter inches in width, with a broad white stripe in the middle; and by women on the left shoulder, suspended from a riband of the same colour and width, fashioned into a bow.
- 5. The decoration shall be awarded for distinguished service of a high order in any field including service rendered by Government servants.
- Any person without distinction of race, occupation, position or sex shall be eligible for the award.
- 7. The decoration may be awarded postliumously.
- 8. The names of the persons, upon whom the decoration is conferred, shall be published in the Gazette of India and a register of all such recipients of the award shall be maintained under the direction of the President.
- \*9 The miniature of the decoration which may be worn on certain occasions by recipients shall be half the size of the PADMA BHUSHAN, and a scaled pattern of the said miniature shall be deposited and kept.
- 10. The President may cancel and annul the award of the decoration to any person and thereupon his name shall be crased from the Register and he shall be required to surrender the decoration and the Sanad. But it shall be competent for the President to restore the decoration and Sanad and to withdraw the orders of cancellation and annulment. The notice of cancellation or restoration in every case shall be published in the Gazette of India.
- 11. All persons upon whom the decoration of PADMA VIBHUSHAN (DUSRA VARG) was conferred under the Regulations issued with Notification No. 2-Pres/54, dated the 2nd January, 1954, shall, for all purposes of these regulations, be decuad to persons on whom the decoration of PADMA BHUSHAN has been conferred by the President.



No. 4-Pros/55—The President is pleased to make the following revised regulations for the award of the decoration PADMA SIRI in supersession of those published in Notification No. 2-Pros/54, dated the 2nd January, 1954—


- The decoration shall be conferred by the President by a Sanad under his hand and seal,
- 2. The decuration shall be malely circular in design, with a geometrical pattern superimposed on the circle (us in the representative drawing in the amexure). The diameter of the circular portion of the decoration shall be one and three-fourth inches and the thickness of the decoration shall be oneeighth of an Inch. The geometrical pattern shall be composed of the outer lines of a square of one and three-sixteenths inches side, controlly placed on each side of which shall be a rectangle projecting bayond the rim thereby breaking the circumference of the circular design of the decoration. A knot shall be combonsed within each of the outer angles of the geometrical pattern towards the rim. There shall be a raised alreular space of dismotor one and one-sixteenth inches forming the centre-piece of the decoration. On the obverse a lotus flower shall be embossed in this circular space. The name of the decoration shall be embossed in Hindl, with the word PADMA placed above and die word SHRI placed below the lotus flower. On the reverse shall be embossed the State Emblem and motto in Hindl below it. The decoration shall be of toned bronze, The inscription PADMA SHRI on the obverse of the decoration, the geometrical pattern on either side and the border around the periphery, shall be of burnished bronze. All embossing on either side of the decoration shall be of stainless steel.
- 3. A scaled pattern of the decoration (manufactured according to the specifications described above and the drawing in the annexure to these regulations) shall be deposited and kept,

- 4. The decoration shall be worn by mon on the left breast, suspended from a lotus pink riband one and a quarter inches in width with two narrow white stripes each a quarter inch distant from the edges of the riband; and by women on the left shoulder, suspended from a riband of the same colour and width fushioned into a bow.
- The decoration shall be awarded for distinguished service in any field including service rendered by Government servants.
- Any person without distinction of eaco, occupation, position or sex shall be eligible for the award.
- The decoration may be awarded posthumously,
- B. The names of the persons, upon whom the decoration is conferred, shall be published in the Gazette of India and a register of all such recipients, shall be maintained under the direction of the President.
- \*9. The ministure of the decoration which may be worn on certain occasions by recipionts shall be half the size of the PADMA SHRI and a scaled pattern of the said ministure shall be deposited and kent.
- 10. The President may cancel and annul the award of the decoration to any person and thereupon his name shall be crased from the Register and he shall be required to surrender the decoration and the Sanad. But it shall be competent for the President to restore the decoration and Sanad and to withdraw the orders of especiation and annulment. The notice of cancellation or restoration in every case shall be published in the Gazette of India.
- 11. All persons upon whom the decoration of PADMA VIDHUSHAN (TISRA VARG) was conforred under the Regulations issued with Notification No. 2-Pres/54, dated the 2nd January, 1954, shall, for all purposes of these regulations, be deemed to persons on whom the decoration of PADMA SHRI has been conferred by the President.
