- (b) whether the derailment and accident of Bikaner-Guwahati Express on 13 January, 2022 in Jalpaiguri is because of the fake rail-track inspection or other reasons have come to fore;
- (c) the details of the action taken on the cases of negligence in railway track inspection and repair works during the last three years; and
- (d) whether the chances of such accidents are increasing due to the lack of trained staff and privatisation in Railways?
