Minister's visit to Sri Lanka

*151. SHRI ANUBHAV MOHANTY:
Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Minister has made an official visit to Sri Lanka in the recent past;
- (b) if so, whether the projects undertaken by India in that country were also taken up for discussion during the visit;
- (c) if so, which were the projects discussed; and
- (d) the details of all the projects that India has taken up in that country?

Kendriya Vidyalayas in Andhra Pradesh

*152. SHRI C.M. RAMESH: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) whether 315 vacancies of teaching staff are there in KVs, if so, the details thereof, school-wise;
- (c) since how long they are lying vacant and the reasons therefor and the steps taken to fill those vacancies and by when all the posts are likely to be filled;
- (d) whether the proposals for opening of new KVs in that State are also lying pending in the Ministry for clearance; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and by when those proposals are likely to be cleared?

Cases of manual scavenging

*153. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA: Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the cases of manual scavenging are still being reported across the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of initiatives taken by Government to rehabilitate those involved in this work and funds allocated therefor during the last three years;
- (c) whether Government has conducted any survey to identify the same and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of deaths reported during that period due to manual scavenging, State-wise?

Promotion of clean urban transport in cities

*154. DR. PRABHAKAR KORE: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to promote clean urban transport by building footpath, non-motorized transport, bus rapid transit (BRT), etc. in cities;
- (b) whether Government also proposes to promote the use of clean fuel, electric, hybrid buses and intelligent traffic system in cities; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the categories of cities likely to be covered under the plan?

Schools for physically challenged

*155. SHRI R. VAITHILINGAM: Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government runs schools

for physically challenged and if so, the details thereof, State-wise as on date;

- (b) the details of funds allocated, sanctioned and utilized for such schools during the last three years; and
- (c) whether Government has any proposal to establish some more such schools in the country and if so, the details thereof?

Establishment of Skills University

*156. SHRI RANJIB BISWAL: Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the report submitted by the Working Group for establishment of Skills University is under consideration of Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the decision taken by Government in this regard;
- (c) whether site selection, modalities, etc. for the functioning of the University have also been finalised; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor and the details of progress made, so far, in this regard?

Projects under NLCPR and NEC

*157. SHRIMATI RANEE NARAH: Will the Minister of DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION be pleased to state:

- (a) the allocations made under the Non-Lapsable Central Pool of Resources (NLCPR) and the North Eastern Council (NEC) during 2016-17;
- (b) the amount spent during that period; and
- (c) the number of projects implemented

and completed thereunder during the said period?

Cycling zones and parks under AMRUT

*158. SHRI MD. NADIMUL HAQUE: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the number of new cycling zones and parks created during the last two years under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT); and

(b) the details of funds spent during that period to create new cycling zones and parks, year-wise?

Brucella-free Villages

*159. SHRIMATI RENUKA CHOWDHURY: Will the Minister of SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Department of Biotechnology has launched Brucella-free Villages in certain States;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the steps taken by Government to develop novel diagnostics and vaccination to tackle Brucellosis affecting cattle as well as humans?

Implementation of 6th Pay Commission in Maharashtra

(a) whether the State Government of Maharashtra is awaiting reimbursement from the Central Government for expenditure incurred on 6th Central Pay Commission for teachers and subsequent cadres;

(b) if so, the details thereof and Government's response for the delay in payment; and

(c) by when the remaining arrears would be provided to the State Government?

Allotment of land for residential accommodations

(a) the number and details of the Departmental Pools/Institutions which have been provided land in Delhi for construction of residential accommodations for officials and staff by Land and Development Office during the last three years;

(c) by when the land provided in R.K. Puram area to different institutions would be made encroachment free by the Ministry and Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board?

Regional language news bulletins

(c) if so, the details thereof; and if not, the reasons therefor?

Security and rehabilitation of women

- (a) whether the cases of physical exploitation and rape against girls and women are rising continuously;
- (b) if so, the number of such cases reported during the last two years, State-wise and metropolitan city-wise;
- (c) whether any scheme/strategy has been formulated to provide security and rehabilitation of women who are victims of such kind of social atrocities; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the

details of provisions to make legal measures more stringent?

Implementation of e-municipality project in Odisha

*164. SHRI NARENDRA KUMAR SWAIN: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state whether the Ministry is considering to provide financial assistance of ₹ 11.43 crore to Odisha Government for implementing the e-municipality project?
