Installation of solar power projects on unused railway land

- *61. DR. AMEE YAJNIK: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government has any proposal to utilise its unused land pool for installation of solar power projects;
- (b) if so, the detailed list of nodal agencies and officers appointed for the purpose;
- (c) the details about any proposal from any MNC in this regard and the progress made so far; and
- (d) the details about the time-frame for the completion of the project?

Allocation of Microwave Access spectrum

- *62. SHRI RAVI PRAKASH VERMA: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:
 - (a) whether serious irregularities in

allocation of Microwave Access spectrum in 2015 have been reported by CAG recently;

 - (d) if so, the details thereof; and
 - (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Non-disbursement of MSP to farmers

- (a) whether it is a fact that the farmers in the country are still unable to repay loans due to non-receiving of MSP in the country;

- (c) the disbursement of MSPs to farmers during the said periods; and
- (d) the action taken by Government to safeguard the interests of the farmers?

Construction of railway line from Sakri to Nirmali and from Jhanjharpur to Laukaha

- (c) whether market price for 10 out of 14 Kharif crops was lower than MSP announced by Government, if so, the details thereof?

Armed robbery in Jammu-Delhi Duronto Express
