Shortage of soldiers in armed forces

*361. SHRI AMAR SHANKAR SABLE: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is a shortage of officers and soldiers in the armed forces;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, service-wise;
- (c) whether Government has conducted any study on it during the last three years;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (e) the details of steps taken by Government to tackle the problem of shortage of soldiers in armed forces?

Delay in payment of salary to officials of Prasar Bharati

*362. DR. SANJAY SINH: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that due to the delay by Government, some employees of Prasar Bharati did not get their salaries for the month of February, 2018 on time;
- (b) if so, whether it is also a fact that due to an internal clash between the Ministry and Prasar Bharati the same problem had occurred in October, 2017 as well; and
- (c) if so, the reasons behind such repeated delays and action taken by Government thereon?

**Contracts for live coverage of events
by private firms**

*363. SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a Mumbai based firm had been awarded contracts for live coverage of opening and closing ceremonies of International Film Festival of India, Goa, 2017 instead of Doordarshan which covers bigger events like Republic Day and International Yoga Day;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the reasons and justifications therefor;
- (d) whether Government would initiate an inquiry into the award of the contract to private firms instead of Doordarshan; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

**Rehabilitation of trainee officers
disabled during training**

*364. SHRI PARTAP SINGH BAJWA: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the trainee officers disabled during training at various military academies in the country during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) whether Government proposes to formulate any scheme to absorb such trainee officers including those disabled during training at Indian Air Force Academy, Hyderabad, in suitable alternate employment;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and by when

the proposed scheme will be implemented and if not, the reasons therefor; and

- (d) the details of other steps taken/being taken by Government to rehabilitate the disabled trainees?

Additional funds for MGNREGS

*365. SHRI A.K. SELVARAJ: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether about 88 per cent of the funds available for the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) have already been exhausted halfway through the financial year;
- (b) whether Government had claimed that this year's MGNREGS budget is the highest ever;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that there is a need of an additional amount of ₹ 17,600 crore to meet the requirements under MGNREGS; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**Implementation of minimum wages
under MGNREGA**

*366. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that in many States, Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) wages are lower than those fixed for unskilled agricultural labour under the Minimum Wages Act of States, if so, the details of the difference in the amounts, State-wise;

- (b) the detailed reasons for not accepting the recommendations of the Mahindra Dev Committee, which suggested a convergence of the wages paid under State Minimum Wages Act for unskilled agricultural labour and the MGNREGA wages; and
- (c) the estimated cost if MGNREGA wages are paid at a rate equal to the States Minimum Wages Acts ?

Course for Sanitation Supervisors

*367. SHRI MAHESH PODDAR: Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is planning to start a course for Sanitation Supervisors in the near future;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there is any fixed timeline to start this course; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Implementation of IAY/PMAY

*368. DR. VIKAS MAHATME: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the allocation criteria for Indira Awas Yojana (IAY)/Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY);
- (b) whether allocation is based on the Below Poverty Line (BPL) census;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the role of institutions like Housing & Urban Development Corporation

(HUDCO), National Housing Bank and State Housing Boards in IAY;

(e) whether there is any possibility of linking the housing credit with income generated from Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA); and

(f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Legislation on cleaning river Ganga

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is considering to consult experts to decide who should be held guilty for the pollution in river Ganga;

- (c) whether it is also a fact that Government would soon enact the proposed law to clean river Ganga; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor?

Shortage of pilots in armed forces

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is a shortage of pilots in Navy, Army and Air Force;

- (b) if so, the details of work completion rate under MGNREGA during the last three years;
- (c) the reasons, if any, for failure to complete the work under MGNREGA; and
- (d) whether any concrete steps are being taken to address the failure in completion of works under MGNREGA?

Driving schools for skill development

*372. SHRIMATI VIJILA SATHYANANTH: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is considering to start 2000 driving schools, each on two acres of land;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that Government has invited industry to join hands to impart skill development by way of providing driving skills; and
- (d) if so, the response of Government and the details thereof?

Displacement of people due to establishment of Naval AOB

- (a) the date of establishment of Navy Alternative Operation Base (AOB) in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) whether it is a fact that four villages have been affected due to the above project;
- (c) if so, steps taken by the Ministry as regards displaced persons and the details of assurances given for rehabilitation and resettlement and their implementation;
- (d) whether it is a fact that the Ministry had assured provision of two jetties, employment to eligible youth, Kendriya Vidyalayas, Health Centres, apart from other things, to the displaced; and
- (e) if so, the status of the assurances given to the affected villagers?

Repair work on Mahatma Gandhi bridge in Patna
