#### **Funds allocated under PMAY in Himachal Pradesh**

\*16. SHRIMATI VIPLOVE THAKUR: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the funds allocated to Government of Himachal Pradesh under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) in the financial years 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18;

(b) the names of districts in the State covered under the scheme; and

(c) the number of houses constructed/likely to be constructed in Kangra district under the scheme?

#### **Revision of diversion of forest land for Mission Bhagiradha Project**

\*17. SHRI DHARMAPURI SRINIVAS: Will the Minister of

ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is in receipt of any proposal from Telangana Government seeking revision of diversion of forest land for Mission Bhagiradha Project;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether Government has taken any decision on the matter and if so, the details thereof?

#### **PMPRPY beneficiaries for textile sector**

\*18. PROF. M.V. RAJEEV GOWDA: Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

(a) the number of textile sector employees registered under Pradhan Mantri Paridhan Rojgar Protsahan Yojana (PMPRPY), since its inception, month-wise;

(b) the quantum of funds disbursed under the scheme since its inception, month-wise;

(c) whether it is a fact that beneficiaries have not been able to receive their claims due to errors in Aadhaar linkage to their PAN numbers; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

#### **Harassment and manhandling for open defecation**

\*19. SHRI VISHAMBHAR PRASAD NISHAD: Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

(a) the amount spent for promotion of social awareness under cleanliness drive during the last three years;

(b) whether incidents of manhandling of people defecating in open and their social harassment have come to the notice of Government; and

(c) the steps being taken by Government for creating social awareness in order to curb these incidents and the extent to which such efforts have been fruitful?

#### **Pollution level in Indian cities**

(a) whether it is a fact that a recently concluded study has revealed that most of the cities of the country have become polluted and pollution has become a life threatening menace;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the details of corrective measures Government proposes to undertake to minimise the pollution levels in the country?

#### **Clearance of margin money by HHEC**

(b) whether HHEC is in a very difficult financial position and have sought the help of the Ministry for financial support in order to clear the Margin Money of the company; and

(c) if so, the details thereof and by when the blocked Margin Money would be paid to the company?

#### **Status of BPL card holders in the country**

(a) the number of people in the country having BPL cards as in 2017, Urban and Rural-wise;

(d) whether there are instances of people availing BPL services illegally and if so, the details thereof, along with the steps taken to curb them?

(d) the details of amount spent on restoration of ponds during the last three years and in current year under this scheme, year-wise?

**Scraping of Spike anti-tank guided missiles deal**

(a) whether it is a fact that Government has recently scrapped a USD 500 million deal to develop Spike anti-tank guided missiles, and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether it is also a fact that Spike was selected earlier after a long and rigorous process and complying with all the defence procurement regulations; and

(c) if so, the specific reasons for cancellation of the said deal?

**Land acquired under Bharatmala Project**

(e) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken to approve such project?

(c) if so, what steps are taken by Government to mitigate the loss of forest and wildlife at Panna Tiger Reserve?

(d) whether Government has any concrete timeline, as to when Ganga will finally be cleaned?
