Special Trains

196 # Shri Neeraj Dangi:

Will the Minister of **Railways** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of trains currently operational which are being run as special trains in the country due to COVID-19 pandemic;
- (b) whether the public is getting the benefit of ordinary railway service or is paying extra due to the operation of special trains, the details thereof; and
- (c) by when Government will discontinue the additional charge and mandatory reservation in special trains and provide general railway service to the public, the details thereof?

Proposal for a separate annual Budget for agriculture

Will the Minister of **Agriculture and Farmers Welfare** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any proposal to introduce a separate annual budget for agriculture with the objective of increasing agricultural productivity, protecting farmers' welfare and working out legislation(s) to regulate ground water use to protect the interests of both farmers and common people dependent on ground water as there are some water deficient States in the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and steps being taken therefor, State-wise and if not, the reasons therefor?

Restarting railway line in Jodhpur

Will the Minister of **Railways** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the railway line constructed for the transportation of stones from mines owned by the princely State in Jodhpur metropolitan area and whether Government proposes to restart the said railway line;
- (b) the total length of the said railway line and the area of land utilized for this along with Khasara-wise details of ownership and area of that land; and

(c) whether Government proposes to use the above land for any other purpose in future, if so, the details thereof?

Railway projects in Andhra Pradesh

Will the Minister of **Railways** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Andhra Pradesh Government has expressed its inability to share the cost for construction of the new line between Nadikudi and Sri Kalahasti;
- (b) if so, the likely future of the project after State Government's refusal;
- (c) whether State Government has also expressed unwillingness to share cost of other railway infrastructure projects, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Ministry considers alternate investment proposals to ensure completion of such ongoing projects;
- (e) the status of the project involving doubling of railways line between Guntur and Guntakal; and
- (f) the nature of development planned for Narasaraopet and Vinukonda railway stations?

Wastage of foodgrains

- (a) whether it is a fact that every year large quantity of foodgrains that is stored in godowns gets wasted;
- (b) if so, whether Government would consider distributing some portion of foodgrains that is stored in godowns for years together to the marginalised sections of the society thereby making space in godowns for storing fresh foodgrains, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of percentage of foodgrains lost every year because of poor maintenance; and
- (d) the steps taken by Government to modernize the godowns of Food Corporation of India (FCI), the details thereof?

Shortage of fertilisers in Jharkhand

- (a) whether Government is aware of the fact that the farmers are facing a lot of problems due to shortage of fertilisers in Jharkhand, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the quantum of Urea, DAP and NPK in metric tonnes, approved by the Central Government against the demand of the Government of Jharkhand to ensure supply of fertilisers to the State; and
- (c) the quantum of fertilisers, in metric tonnes, allocated by the Central Government to various companies during April to July 2021?

Doubling Thanjavur-Villupuram section in Southern Railway

Production of organic fertilisers

- (a) whether Government has formulated any action plan during the last three years to increase the production of organic fertilisers and to encourage the farmers to use them; and
- (b) if so, the framework of this action plan and the amount of financial expenditure sanctioned by Government in this regard?

Funds spent on Agriculture Infrastructure Fund

Will the Minister of ***Agriculture and Farmers Welfare*** be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantum of funds spent so far from the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund of ₹1 lakh crore for farm gate based infrastructure for farmers, announced on 15th May, 2020;
- (b) the number of farmers, agricultural cooperative societies, entrepreneurs, start-ups and farmer producer organisations that have benefitted from the said scheme so far, State-wise; and
- (c) the achievements made from the said funds so far in terms of marketing infrastructure, logistic infrastructure, modern packaging, cold storage system and PPP projects, etc., the details thereof, State-wise?

Schemes for welfare of tea garden labourers

- (d) if so, the details thereof and Government's response thereto?

- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?
