Iron and Arsenic contamination in drinking water

61 Smt. Jharna Das Baidya:

Will the Minister of **Jal Shakti** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether huge amounts of iron and arsenic which is injurious to human life are found in drinking water of Northeastern States;
- (b) if so, by when clean drinking water would be provided to the people in the North-Eastern region particularly, Tripura;
- (c) whether Government has any schemes or initiative in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Best practices for maintaining Air Quality Index

62 Shri Rajmani Patel:

Will the Minister of **Environment, Forest and Climate Change** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware that the State of Punjab recorded a moderate Air Quality Index (AQI) in September-October 2020 despite 11,000 stubble burning cases, whereas Delhi's AQI was poor during the same period;
- (b) whether Government has identified causes for this difference between the two region's AQI;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether Government has identified good practices of the State Government of Punjab to reduce air pollution; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor?

Prevention of wildlife trafficking of Red Pandas and Indian Pangolins

Will the Minister of **Environment, Forest and Climate Change** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of red pandas and Indian pangolins in Singaila National Park and Neora Valley National Park in West Bengal over the last three years;

- (c) whether Government is aware of this decrease and has taken note of their cross-border poaching;
- (d) if so, targeted steps Government has undertaken to deal with this problem;
- (e) whether Government plans to develop a cross-border anti-trafficking network of bureaucrats, local stakeholders, environmentalists, NGOs and communities; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

Ceasefire violations by Pakistan

- (a) the details of cases of ceasefire violations by Pakistan during the last one year, till date;
- (b) the number of persons who died due to ceasefire violations by Pakistan along with the details of loss of property; and
- (c) the details of steps taken by Government to strengthen the border security in view of recent violation of ceasefire by Pakistan?

Human-animal conflict in the country

- (a) whether Government is aware of the fact that the population of various wild species have multiplied during the last few years and that they are posing danger by encroaching into agriculture fields and nearby human habitations, near forest borders due to insufficient food and water; and
- (b) if so, the measures taken by Government to control the human-animal conflict in the country?

Jaipur-Ajmer Expressway

Will the Minister of **Road Transport and Highways** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of concessional period and rate of toll determined according to the traffic census and construction cost which was done prior to commencement of constructing Jaipur-Ajmer Expressway;
- (b) whether concessional period and toll rate have been increased from time to time even after starting toll on the Jaipur-Ajmer Expressway toll road, if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) whether traffic census has been conducted every year after starting toll on the Jaipur-Ajmer Expressway toll road, if so, the details thereof?

Releasing funds to Polavaram project

- (c) whether it is a fact that Government is facing some hurdles in auctioning of these mines in Chhattisgarh, if so, the details thereof and the steps being taken by Government to remove these hurdles?
