Domestic production of electronic hardware

136 **Dr. Amar Patnaik:**

Will the Minister of **Electronics and Information Technology** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total domestic production of electronic hardware including semiconductors in the last five years;
- (b) the total import and export of semiconductors in India in the last three years;
- (c) whether Government has taken any steps to boost the manufacturing of semiconductors in India amidst a global shortage;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether Government has any proposals to boost the manufacturing of small and medium electronic components and semiconductors under a Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

CONCOR disinvestment

Will the Minister of **Railways** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Container Corporation of India Ltd (CONCOR) has the largest network of inland containers depots / container freight stations in India and can be expanded to cover management of ports, air cargo complexes and establishing cold chain ;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that Government has started the process of disinvesting this important PSU and hence losing its management control; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor?

Industrial nodes in Andhra Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh

Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

- (a) the industrial nodes (cities) identified under various Industrial Corridors in Andhra

- (c) the present status of nodes with regard to identification of land, formation of Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV), transfer of land to SPV, infrastructure development etc.;
- (d) the cost estimates for various infrastructure components along with contribution from Central Government for different nodes;
- (e) the sanction status of funds released for each node; and
- (f) the employment potential of each node?

Railway stations shutdown during lockdown

- (e) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Railway for their evacuation and settlement for these poor people?

Compensation for crop loss due to hailstorm and natural calamities

- (c) if not, whether any such scheme which provides benefits to female farmers is under consideration, if so, the details thereof?

Implementation of Consumer Protection Act, 2019

- (a) whether it is a fact that under the e-commerce rules notified under Consumer Protection Act, 2019, all e-commerce entities have been mandated to incorporate as a company; and
- (b) if so, the reason for excluding proprietorship, Hindu Undivided Families (HUF) and partnerships to sell goods online?

Rise in the prices of essential commodities

- d) if so, the details thereof for the month of November, 2021 and reasons therefor; and
- e) the steps taken to contain the price rise?

Funding of Startups at seed stage

- (a) the number of Startups funded at the seed stage during the last five years;
- (b) the details of allocation of funds, year-wise;

Acquisition of land in Goa for double tracking

- (d) at what rate compensation has been calculated and how much compensation has been paid so far?

Transportation of oxygen by Railways

- (e) if so, details thereof, if not, reasons therefor?

Revival of textile industry
