# Soil erosion on banks of river Ganga

†\*256. SHRI AHMAD ASHFAQUE KARIM: Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the lands and homes of people living at Manihari, Amdabad, Barari and Kursaila blocks of Katihar district in Bihar have been destroyed, due to erosion of banks by river Ganga making the lives of people of this most backward area miserable;
- (b) whether Government has any effective plan to stop such erosion of banks by river Ganga in such regions; and
- (c) whether Government has any plan to provide compensation to such victims due to erosion of banks by river Ganga?

# Flyover at Golagamudi junction in Nellore, Andhra Pradesh

- \*257. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether any request has been received in the Ministry or National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) for construction of a flyover at Golagamudi junction, where National Highways of Kolkata and Chennai sections intersect, in Nellore district of Andhra Pradesh on NH-16;
- (b) whether the Ministry or NHAI is aware that engineering college students, devotees and common people face extreme difficulties in crossing the road and many accidents have taken place on this dangerous intersection; and
- (c) if so, steps taken by Ministry to construct a flyover at Golagamudi junction to avoid accidents and ensure smooth flow of traffic?

#### Monitoring of accidents on NHs

- (a) whether Government proposes to give directions to the toll management companies to monitor accidents on National Highways (NHs) so that the said companies could provide ambulance and first-aid services, at the earliest to the victims of accidents:
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the number of deaths that took place in road accidents during the last three years and the current year, State-wise; and
- (d) the steps being taken/likely to be taken by Government to reduce road accidents?

#### Environmental impact of Ahmedabad-Mumbai High Speed Rail

- (a) the area of forest land, including mangroves, that would be lost, due to the construction of Ahmedabad-Mumbai High Speed Rail, location-wise;
- (b) details of enviornmental clearances given to projects by Ministry;
- (c) details of steps proposed to be taken to compensate for the environmental loss;
- (d) details of consultations with the locals, to convey the impact of project to them;
- (e) the details of concerns voiced out by the people in these consultations; and
- (f) details of steps proposed to be taken to address those concerns?

#### Aadhaar linking for MGNREGA

- \*262. SHRI RITABRATA BANERJEE: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Aadhaar linking for MGNREGA enrolments has been mandated, if so, reasons therefor;
- (b) total number and percentage of workers who linked their Aadhaar numbers

to job cards and whether this has benefited the scheme and if so, details thereof;

- (c) whether Government is providing and promoting an Aadhaar opt-out option, if so, progress made thereof;
  - (d) if not, reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether Government has conducted or is aware of any study conducted to evaluate benefits of Aadhaar linking in timelines of payments, increasing enrolment, removing corruption and identifying fakes and duplicates and if so, details thereof?

# Geotagging of rural eevelopment works

- (a) whether Government has started using geotagging as an audit technique for rural development works, if so, the details thereof:

- (d) whether the local bodies have a role to play in this audit, if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (e) the benefits of geotagging as compared to other auditing techniques; and
- (f) the details of the funds allocated and utilised for this purpose so far?

# Exemption from road permits for electric vehicles

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government proposes to exempt road permits for Electric Vehicles (EVs) and also for vehicles that run on alternative fuels, such as CNG and Ethanol;

- (c) if so, details of the policy and the time-frame for its implementation?

- (e) whether any targets have been fixed for completion of the Expressway, if so, the details thereof: and
- (f) the measures being taken by Government to expedite the execution of the project, for its early completion?

#### Release of MGNREGA fund to Karnataka

- (a) whether Ministry is aware that Government of Karnataka has released ₹1,227 crores during 2015-16 and 2016-17 as an advance release, under MGNREGA which is over and above the State's share:
- (b) whether it is a fact that ₹ 1,090 crores are yet to be released to the State by the Ministry;
- (c) if so, reasons for not releasing the amount in spite of repeated requests from the State Government; and
- (d) by when the Ministry would release the above amount to Karnataka?

- (d) whether any enquiry has been ordered to find out lapses on the part of forest officials or Railways for train not slowing down in the vulnerable areas;
  - (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) details of measures taken in the past and proposed to be taken to avoid death of wild animals in accidents?

## Discharge of industrial waste into the rivers

# Groundwater pollution in Chhattisgarh

- (b) whether it is also a fact that there are many districts where groundwater used to be fit for drinking, but has now become polluted;
  - (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the reasons for groundwater pollution and the steps taken to prevent it?
