Measures to counter violence in North Eastern Region

- (a) whether it is a fact that in just over two years 35 major incidents of violence were reported from the North Eastern Region; and
- (b) the measures taken to counter the militant groups operating in North Eastern States?

Sexual harassment of women in police custody
