Enquiry reports on helicopter crashes

*541. SHRI AMAR SINGH: SHRIMATI SUKHBUNS KAUR:

- (a) the number of choppers (civilian) which crashed during the last three years alongwith the causes of each crash;
- (b) what action Government have taken in the light of findings of enquiries conducted in this regard;
- (c) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the recent statement by IAF's Director-General (Inspection and Safety) after the recent mishap resulting in the deaths of two Ministers of Haryana Government to the effect that stringent norms for selection of pilots and helicopters and a review of Civil Aviation Rules enacted in 1934 can go a long way in preventing the mishaps; and
- (d) if so, what is Government's reaction in regard thereto and by when, the rules are likely to be reviewed?

Space crunch at major airports
