Adverse impact of import of agricultural products

- *461. SHRI THANGA TAMIL SELVAN: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:
- (a) the details of the agricultural products imported during the last three years;
- (b) whether Government have conducted any survey to assess the adverse impact of such imports on the domestic growers/producers;
- (c) whether it is a fact that this import is driving farmers to commit suicide in various parts of the country; and
- (d) if so, the steps taken by Government to protect Indian farmers?

Export of Indian Coffee

- *462. DR. M.A.M. RAMASWAMY: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the Coffee Board has engaged any consultants in order to regain its lost market;

- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by Government to boost export of Indian Coffee?

Implementation of NREG Act

- *463. SHRI S.S. AHLUWALIA: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) whether implementation of the National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (NREGA) has started;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, including the mechanism and frequency of periodical monitoring of its implementation in the targeted States by Government;
- (c) the details of the persons seeking jobs under NREGA and those duly given jobs in the course of the first two months of implementation of the Act, State-wise;
- (d) the nature of problems, if any, witnessed commonly/severally by the States in implementation of the NREGA during the initial period?

DRDO global tie-ups in aerospace

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO) proposes to have global tie-ups in aerospace;

Withdrawal of army from valley

- (c) whether large scale arrests of terrorists and the above statement would not create fear among the local citizens?

Foreign investment in single branded retailing

- (c) what are the details of the employees retrenched during the above period in public sector, year-wise; and
- (d) how Government are planning to increase the number of employment opportunities, apart from Employment Guarantee Scheme?

- (a) whether it is a fact that Lashkar-e-Taiba terrorists are planning to target Bhabha Atomic Research Centre at Mumbai by using suicide bomber and plan to destroy Mumbai city by using F-16 and Mirage-5 bombers;
- (b) whether it is a fact that suicide mission terrorists are planning their bomber

plan with Atomic Energy Centre itself; and

(c) if so, whether Government intends to avert probable attacks on Mumbai city by Pak Terrorists using F-16, Mirage-5 bombers, keeping in view the revelations made by Lashkar-e-Taiba terrorists caught at Nagpada, Mumbai recently?

Protection of domestic growers of Virginia tobacco

- (a) whether Government have any plans to protect domestic growers of Virginia tobacco from low-cost imports;

- (c) what steps Government propose to take to protect tobacco farmers to ensure that they are not put into economic crisis by weak import policies and low import tariffs?
