Demand for greater Nagaland

- *1. SHRI MANOJ BHATTACHARYA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether there has been a persistent demand on the part of Naga leaders for the formation of a greater Nagaland with parts of the territories from Manipur, Arunachal Pradesh and Assam and if so, the details thereof and Government's reaction thereto;
- (b) whether there has also been a demand for a separate State comprising of the Garo Hills, if so, details thereof; and
- (c) the steps proposed to be taken by Government to address the problems of the tribal people in the North-Eastern Region so as to retain them as citizens of the Indian Union with equality and dignity?

Bomb blasts in Delhi

- (c) whether Government have since identified the organization behind this dastardly act and if so, the details and action taken to arrest them?

State Police Acts

Emphasis on hydro power in new power policy
