Report of ICAR-NISA, Ranchi

As part of the Swachhta Hi Sewa Campaign 2025, Team 5 of ICAR-NISA, Ranchi, successfully organized a Safai Mitra Suraksha Shivar on September 21, 2025, at the Institute Health Centre. The event provided comprehensive preventive health check-ups including physical examinations, vital sign monitoring, and laboratory tests for all 21 of the institute's sanitation workers, leading to the identification of three cases requiring follow-up care. Alongside personalized health counselling on occupational safety and hygiene, the team facilitated crucial linkages to government welfare schemes such as Ayushman Bharat and PM Awas Yojana. This initiative achieved its dual objectives of addressing immediate health concerns and establishing a foundation for long-term social security, thereby enhancing the dignity and well-being of the sanitation workforce and reinforcing ICAR-NISA's commitment to their welfare.

Activity 1. : Distribution of PPE Kits & Safety Gear

On the Day-5 of SHS 2025 programme (i.e. 21.9.2025), a cleanliness drive was carried out by ICAR-IIWM *Swachhta* team in the premises of 12th century Buddhanath Temple located in Garedipanchan village of Balipatna block in Khurda district, with the participation of village people. A portion of the premise along the boundary wall covering an area of about 1500m² was cleaned by removing the unwanted herbs including parthenium spp., shrubs, polythene wrappers, polythene bags, stones, broken glasses etc. The branches of some of the trees in the premise were also pruned to give them a proper shape. The debris that littered the premises, plant parts and weeds were collected and disposed outside the premises. The boundary walls covered with unwanted creepers were also cleaned. Under Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam, 30 saplings were planted in the premises by the participants. At the end, the participants shared their views for making the premises beautiful and pleasant for the visitors.

The [Hindu](#) temple dedicated to Lord [Shiva](#) attracts devotees from far off places. Spread over about a hectare area, the temple premises require urgent attention in the form of regular cleaning, plantation and maintenance of saplings for its beautification. In this context, ICAR-IIWM has teamed up with the people of the village under *Swachh Bharat Abhiyan* to make the premises of this 800-year-old temple clean and green. Programme: Safai Mitra Suraksha Shivirs (Single-window Camps for Preventive Health Check-ups and Linkage with Welfare Schemes)

Theme: *Swachhotsav* (as part of *Swachhta Hi Seva*)

On 21st September 2025, a Safai Mitra Suraksha Shivir was organized under the theme *Swachhotsav* as part of the *Swachhta Hi Seva* initiative to promote the health and well-being of sanitation workers and their families. The camp offered preventive health check-ups and information on government welfare schemes through a single-window facility. Participants underwent screenings for blood pressure, blood sugar, BMI, and vision, with consultations and referrals provided for follow-up care. Awareness sessions on hygiene, nutrition, and occupational safety were conducted, and educational materials distributed. The event received active participation, increased awareness, and facilitated early detection of health issues, successfully integrating healthcare and welfare outreach

Safai Mitra Suraksha Shivirs

1. Organisation of Camps to Benefit Sanitation Workers and Their Families in Chatarkhaar Village, Mungeli District, Chhattisgarh

Special awareness and service camps will be organised in **Chatarkhaar village** to improve the overall well-being of sanitation workers and their families. These camps will include:

- **Awareness Sessions:** Information on personal hygiene, sanitation practices, nutrition, and preventive healthcare to reduce the incidence of work-related diseases.
- **Skill Development & Training:** Orientation programs to build awareness of alternative livelihood options, financial literacy, and social security schemes.
- **Family Welfare Support:** Counselling and guidance for the education of children, support for women empowerment through SHGs (Self Help Groups), and linkages with vocational training institutes.

The camp aims to not only address the immediate health and welfare concerns but also ensure the dignity and inclusiveness of sanitation workers in the social fabric of the village.

2. Facilitation of Linkage with Welfare Schemes for Sanitation Workers and Their Dependents in Chamari Village, Mungeli District, Chhattisgarh

A focused initiative will be undertaken in Chamari village to connect sanitation workers and their family members with government welfare schemes and entitlements. The activities will include:

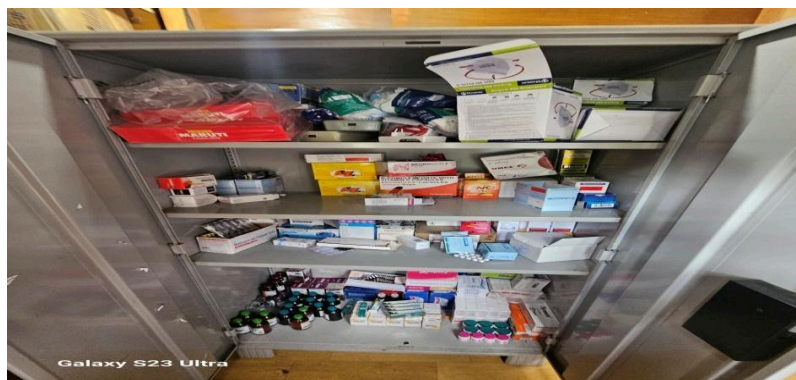
- **Awareness Drives:** Educating sanitation workers about the benefits available under schemes such as Ayushman Bharat (health insurance), Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maandhan Yojana (pension), and state-level welfare programs.
- **Documentation & Support Services:** Assistance in preparing and submitting necessary documents (Aadhaar, ration card, caste/income certificates, etc.) to ensure smooth enrolment in welfare programs.
- **Social Security Linkages:** Facilitating access to financial inclusion schemes like Jan Dhan Yojana, accident insurance, maternity benefits, and other social safety nets.
- **Follow-up and Monitoring:** Establishing a monitoring mechanism through community volunteers and Panchayat members to ensure that enrolled beneficiaries receive timely benefits without delays.

This initiative will strengthen the socio-economic security of sanitation workers in Chamari village by reducing their vulnerability and enhancing access to healthcare, education, and livelihood opportunities for their dependents.

Report on Swachhta Hi Sewa–2025 Activities at ICAR-IIAB, Ranchi

On 21st September 2025, ICAR–Indian Institute of Agricultural Biotechnology (IIAB), Ranchi, actively participated in the nationwide campaign Swachhta Hi Sewa–2025. The event brought together more than 70–80 participants, including students of IIAB, rural tribal livestock farmers, and institute staff, to promote cleanliness, health awareness, and responsible waste disposal practices.

The programme commenced with a vaccination (Duck Plague vaccine) drive for Khaki Campbell ducks, highlighting the institute’s commitment to animal health as part of the One Health approach. Hands-on exposure was assured to maintain healthy animal husbandry practices, which, as a whole, address the general health care of humans.

A special training session was organized for the Swachhta workers of IIAB on proper methods of laboratory waste disposal. They were given hands-on exposure to safe handling and disposal of tissue samples, blood, and other biomedical wastes, ensuring scientific practices are followed to safeguard health and the environment. Farmers were sensitized on safe disposal of animal carcasses to prevent the spread of infections. Students and farmers also received awareness on communicable disease prevention, linking the importance of sanitation, vaccination, and waste management to the One Health framework that integrates human, animal, and environmental health.

The campaign concluded with a collective pledge to sustain cleanliness and adopt safe waste disposal practices. The event not only created awareness but also strengthened community engagement towards building a healthier, cleaner society.
