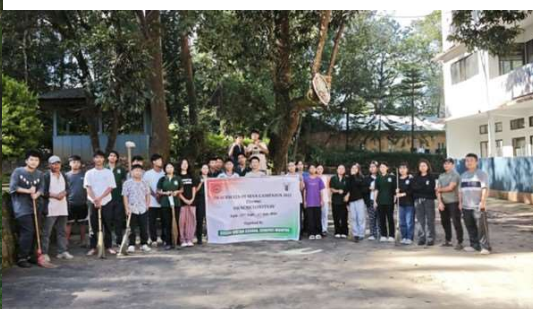

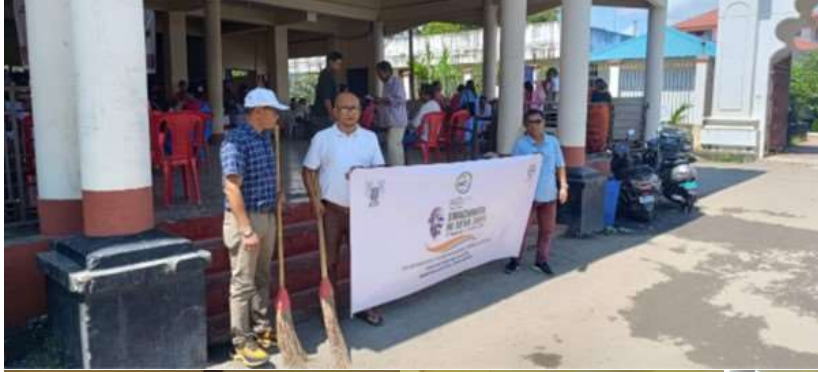














## ICAR-VPKAS, Almora

## Recognition of most unique and inspiring initiatives undertaken by local bodies to integrate citizens with swachhta, local art, music and culture

- With the effort of local bodies and whole community, Padamchen, East Sikkim has been declared as the cleanest village of Sikkim. Padamchen being the tourist place, lots of waste was generated during the tourist visit and Pangolakha Wildlife Sanctuary located in close proximity which is the home to red pandas. To solve the waste problem, the local bodies collected all the plastic waste and made it into bags and basket. It is still a model village in Sikkim for waste management.
- Government has banned the use of single use plastic and plastic bottles in Sikkim since 2022.

## Waste to Art Initiatives

Maize which is one of the import cereal crops of Sikkim, its husk is considered waste and is either thrown away or used as feed for the cattle. However, the women of Sikkim are making handicrafts such as flower bouquets and button flower badge from maize husk which is used



during functions or any programmes. The maize husk is also used to prepare sitting mat by the local villagers.



In Sikkim, especially in the villages, bamboo basket is being used as a dustbin rather than plastic dustbin making environment clean and safe.



A waste such as paint box is being used as a flower pot



Besides these, cleanliness drive was conducted at the research farm of our centre under this programme.
