VACANCY NOTICE

Applications are invited from eligible and interested candidates to fill up one (01) un-reserved post of Assistant Legal Adviser in the Level-7 (Rs.44900-142400) of 7th CPC Pay Matrix (Pre-revised Pay Band-2 of Rs.9300-34800 with Grade Pay of Rs.4600/-) in the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) Hqrs., Krishi Bhawan, Dr. Rajendra Prasad Marg, New Delhi-110001 on direct recruitment basis. The details regarding the eligibility conditions etc. are as under:

2. Introduction

The Indian Council of Agricultural Research is an autonomous body under the Department of Agriculture Research & Education, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India. The Council follows the rules of Govt. of India for its administrative staff *mutatis mutandis*.

3. Legal Cadre in ICAR :- There are two posts of Assistant Legal Adviser in ICAR. One post is at the ICAR Headquarters, New Delhi and the other at Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi. The following is the cadre hierarchy :-

- (a) Legal Adviser (Group-A) in the Level-12 of the 7th CPC pay matrix;
- (b) Law Officer (Group-B) in the Level-9 of the 7th CPC pay matrix;
- (c) Assistant Legal Adviser (Group-B) in Level-7 of the 7th CPC pay matrix.

4. Illustrative duties attached to the post of ALA are as under:-

"Arranging of the defense of the cases/contesting of the cases/vetting of the petitions, replies, applications and appeals etc. from legal point of view.

Besides this vetting and examination of the HBA application, patent application/agreements/contracts/drafting of pleadings/courts orders/MoUs/MoAs/rendering of legal advice in the legal matters/liaison with the advocates and other judicial authorities and also to appear before various Commissions along with the concerned officers of the ICAR as and when required. The applicants having wider experience in handling the labour court cases, service matters, arbitration matters and land & property matters etc. will be given preference."

5. Citizenship: Applicant must be a citizen of India.

6. Essential eligibility conditions as per the recruitment rules of the post:-

a) Educational & Other qualifications:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Law from a recognized University.
- Candidate should be an Advocate as defined in the Advocates Act 1961 (25 of 1961) who has practiced as such for five years

OR

- Should have worked in Central Government/State Government/Autonomous Organizations in the Legal Department for at least five years

OR

- Both dealing with legal matters.

Note I: The prescribed essential qualifications are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle the candidate(s) to be called for the Written Test.

Note II: The candidate should mention all the qualifications and experience in the relevant field over and above the minimum qualifications and should attach self attested copies of the certificates including mark sheets in support thereof.

Note III: In support of Educational Qualifications, mere submission of the mark sheets alone in lieu of Degree/Diploma/Educational Certificates will not be accepted by the Council.

Note IV: The provisional claim whatsoever in regard to eligibility criteria for the post(s) will not be accepted by the Council.

Note V: The date of determining the eligibility, educational qualifications, experience and age limit prescribed shall be the last date prescribed for submission of application i.e. 30 days from the date of its publication in the Employment News/Rozgar Samachar.

b) Age as on the closing date of notification: 24 to 35 years.

{ The upper age is relaxable for SC/ST/OBC etc. as per the Government of India rules. The upper age is also relaxable up to 45 years in the case of serving regular employees of ICAR in the administrative (ministerial) category.}

7. FEE for application:

- (a) The applicants must pay the prescribed fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) through Demand Draft drawn on any scheduled bank in favour of "Secretary, ICAR" payable at Delhi/New Delhi.
- (b) No fee is to be paid by SC, ST, PwD and Women applicants. However, the OBC applicants are required to pay the full prescribed fee of Rs 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only).
- (c) The fee remitted through any other mode viz Money Order, Indian Postal Orders, Crossed Cheques, Currency Notes and Treasury Challans etc. will not be accepted by the Council and such applications will be treated as without fee and will be summarily rejected.
- (d) Application not accompanied by the full prescribed fee, wherever payable, will not be considered and summarily rejected. No representation against such rejection will be entertained
