

Daily report on Swachchata Hi Sewa (18 Sept. 2018)

Regular monitoring of this work was taken up by the farm unit.

Regular Maintenance/Cleaning/Sanitation:

Daily cleaning work was taken up in all the buildings such as sweeping, mopping etc. and awareness was created among all the employees on daily cleaning of individual rooms. Daily cleaning of staff rooms, corridors in all the buildings was taken up on regular basis. The wash rooms were cleaned and naphthalene balls and air fresheners were applied for maintaining the hygiene. The fish aquariums were installed in various buildings viz. Health Centre, Faculty House and Faculty Centre were regularly cleaned, timely feeding was also done to maintain the good health of fishes and on regular interval water also changed in aquariums.
