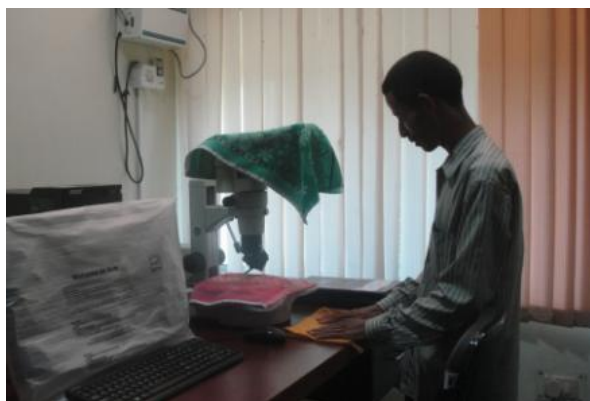

- **Swachhta Shapath** was undertaken by the Scientists, Students, and Staff, on the very first day of **Swachhta Pakhwada**;
- A series of cleanliness drives including cleaning and sweeping of offices, corridors and premises, weeding out old records, disposing of old and obsolete furniture & junk materials:
- Individual chambers/ offices, laboratories and the corridors were cleaned; Laboratories were also re-organized, by discarding old chemical solutions, samples etc. ; and all the old papers were screened out, segregated and put at proper place for future use;
- Working areas, slabs, chemical & media racks, storage selves, refrigerator, equipments in laboratories were cleaned; while the chemicals & media were re-arranged;
- The area located between Animal Biochemistry Division and Library was also cleaned during this period;
- Facilitation in wider adoption of the bio-waste management towards minimizing as well as processing of the bio-wastes into clean and environment-friendly bio-fuels and organic manures;
- Effective waste management and use of composite manure for improving soil fertility;
- Collection/arrangement of 'Organic Waste Materials', like Organic garbage, tree-leaves, etc. for the purpose of being spread in the 'Compost Pit(s)'.
- Focus on propagation of 'Clean and Organic farming practices' among the farming community for improving the environment and the soil-health;
- Each and every corner of Livestock Research Centre (LRC), including Goat section, Calf section, Chaff cutter, Milking section as well as different paddocks of different categories of livestock were cleaned during this period;
- Awareness Campaign on "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan" in the nearby villages;
- As the institute is engaged in activities pertaining to the transfer of technologies/ package of practices in the adopted villages including field-days, technology demonstrations, on-farm & off-farm training programmes, in their areas of operation, the 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' have been integrated with these 'Transfer of Technology'(TOT) programmes.

Apart from these afore-mentioned activities, some of the Sections of the Institute, including Estate, Livestock Research Centre (LRC), Maintenance Engineering (ME), Farm Section, etc. also undertook such 'Cleanliness Drive(s)' during the afore-said period, while contributing towards this mission of "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan".
